Due to the financial support of I.W.A. the first phase will be completed on the Shipley to Bingley stretch and to mark the achievement an official unveiling ceremony will be held at **12 midday on Thursday 23rd October 2008 at Dockfield Road, Shipley**

The project has been co-ordinated by Howard Tomlinson of Dreamweavers (Marine Division of B.M.E.P.) and two of our senior trainees have been involved in all aspects of pattern making, casting of the mile plates, surveying the sites and installation of the posts.
