The Short Boat Kennet is one of the last unconverted boats which worked on the Leeds & Liverpool Canal and is on the National Register of Historic Vessels. It has displays about the Leeds & Liverpool in its hold and travels the length of the canal to events, festivals and organizations where it is open to the public free of charge.
